Principal Study	Level 4	60 credits	Credits within this module may be split if you follow a Second or Related Study (you must audition for Second Study). <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Level 4 Related Study = 0 credits • Level 5 Related Study = 10 credits • Level 4 Second Study = 20 credits
Historical Studies	Level 4	20 credits

Aural	Levels 4, 5 or 6	10 credits	During the course of the year you opt to take whichever level you prefer
