

Monstera Deliciosa

Basics



Bright but indirect sunlight



Water when soil is dry
Once every 1-2 weeks



Likes high humidity



16° – 24° Celcius

Crucial tips

Avoid direct sun



Fertilize in summer: every 2 weeks
In winter: none or fertilizer sticks



Ideally place in bathroom
Or occasionally use mist spray



Use pole to give Monstera support
and help it grow and climb



Repotting



Remove Monstera from
pot and massage root
ball.



Put in bigger pot and
start to fill up with new
soil.



Direct aerial roots into
soil. Water deeply.

Common problems & most common explanations



Yellow leaves
Overwatering
Nutrient deficiency
Too little light



Brown leafs
Excessive sunlight
Over- or underwatering
Low humidity

Always keep an eye out for pests! Regularly inspect the Monstera Deliciosa's leaves.

Propagating



Cut stem with at
least two leaves
and one aerial
root. Use sharp
and clean knife.



Put in water.
Submerge aerial
roots. Change
water every few
days.



When thick roots
have developed,
plant in soil.
